

## **National City reports charitable donations**

DAYTON — National City Bank is collecting nonperishable food at its branch offices in support of food banks in the Dayton and Springfield areas.

More than 3,800 cans of food have been collected in an effort to be completed by Dec. 31, company spokesman Lars Eller said.

In addition, the bank authorized its employees to choose who could receive a total of \$71,000 the company set aside for charitable gifts during the last three months of 2008.

National City said those included donations of \$10,000 to The Foodbank, Dayton, and \$5,000 each to St. Vincent de Paul, House of Bread, Senior Resource Connection, AFL-CIO Labor Food Pantry and Fraternal Order of Police Benevolent Fund.
